Seeks an inspiring science instructor who develops students as competent critical thinkers and who engages students through creative, real-world-based instruction. The instructor's primary responsibilities will include teaching multiple sections of Physics, Physics Honors, and Forensic Science. Additional responsibilities may include serving on faculty advisory committees, sponsoring student organizations, or coaching depending on the candidate's interest. Position will begin August 1, 2025.

Job Title: **Science Instructor**

Primary Purpose: **Instruction of**

Physics - This course will emphasize hands-on experimentation as the class studies motion, forces, work, energy, sound, light, electricity, and magnetism. There is a mathematical emphasis on problem solving with examples and questions reflecting real life situations.

Physics Honors - This course will also emphasize hands-on experimentation, problem solving, and real life questioning. Students will have a chance to experience independent study, and project constructions. The students will inter-link the topics covered in the Physics course.

Forensic Science - This course introduces students to the application of science to connect a violation of law to a specific criminal, criminal act, or behavior and victim. Students will learn terminology and procedures related to the search and examination of physical evidence in criminal cases as they perform laboratory investigation.

Potential for other STEM electives depending on candidate's interest and background.
