### ACCREDITATION


St. Joseph High School is accredited by the Texas Catholic Conference of Bishops -Education Department, under the aegis of the Texas Education Agency.

#### **Grading Structure**

The scholastic year is divided into four quarters. Each semester grade is calculated on 40% per quarter average and 20% per exam grade. A 100% GPA scale is used. Averages are weighted by adding 6 points to Honors courses and 8 points to AP and Dual Credit courses in the cumulative GPA calculation. The grading scale is as follows:


## **National Merit**


Since 2022, St. Joseph High School has had 1 National Merit Scholar and 10 National Merit Commended Students.
