St. Joseph High School's student body is rich in ethnic and social diversity. Need-based financial aid is awarded to 22% of students, and an additional 20% benefit from Texas Education Freedom Account assistance.

The ratio and ethnic composition of the student body is **60% White, 28% Hispanic/Latino, 4% Black, 2% Asian, and 6% Multiracial or Other.**

GRADING STRUCTURE

The scholastic year is divided into four quarters. Each semester grade is calculated on 40% per quarter average and 20% per exam grade. A 100% GPA scale is used.

Averages are weighted by adding 6 points to Honors courses and 8 points to AP and Dual Credit courses in the cumulative GPA calculation.

CLASS OF 2026 ACCEPTANCES

The 84 members of the Class of 2026 will attend 23 colleges and universities across seven states. 78% will enroll in four year institutions immediately following graduation, while 14% will begin their postsecondary education at two-year colleges. An additional 6% will enter the workforce or pursue trade or technical training, and 2% will serve in the military.
